**Good Bills (Ask your Senator to Pass):**

**S975 - “SC Medical Freedom Act”** prohibits employers, schools, etc. from mandating novel (newer than ten years) vaccines or gene therapies, prohibits pharmacists from refusing right-to-try medications, and limits the powers of the Department of Public Health during a declared emergency.

**This Bill has passed in the House and is out of Committee in the Senate. H4624 - “Help Not Harm Act”** prevents medical and criminalizes surgical gender transition of minors. Also forces school administrators to inform parents when their child is identifying as another gender. This bill has been passed by the House and is waiting for a second reading by the senate but has been contested and put on hold by Senator Hutto from Orangeburg County.

**Bad Bills (Ask your State Representative to VOTE NO):**

**H5118 "SC 10-Year Energy Transformation Act"** Green New Deal for SC Infringes on private property rights, monopolizes and controls energy production and utilization, and creates an "Energy Policy Institute" to advise legislators on how to use our taxes to fund energy projects. This is another step in transformation from free-market driven energy production into communist, state-controlled equitable "green" energy distribution.

**This Bill has been sent to the House Judiciary Committee.**

**S915 - “Executive Office of Health Policy” (AKA “Health Czar” bill):** Creates a new Secretary of Health and Policy who will be given a massive amount of power over health Policy in SC.

- Transfers from the governor to the Secretary the power to appoint and remove directors of all 5 departments, along with members of all advisory boards and councils.
- Provides no qualification requirements or term limits and no option for removal by the legislature should the Secretary go rogue-only the governor can remove the Secretary.
- Allows interim Secretary, appointed after July 1st, full power of the position without having been confirmed by the Senate.
