Our non-partisan organization, [SCSafeElections.org](https://www.scsafeelections.org), is passionate about making sure your vote counts. According to a recent Rasmussen poll, over 60% of Americans are worried by the evidence of cheating in the midterm elections. Perhaps you are one of them.

The volunteers at SC Safe Elections have spent the past several years evaluating the HUNDREDS of vulnerabilities within our state election machines, pouring over our voter rolls (FILLED with ineligible voters), canvassing counties where voting irregularities have occurred, documenting THOUSANDS of affidavits which we have filed with the Attorney General and SLED, monitoring elections as poll workers and observers (finding LOTS of problems in our June primary), and lobbying our state legislators. We have done all of this in an effort to MAKE SURE YOUR VOTE COUNTS.

Aside from a forensic audit, the best way to verify whether our votes were counted properly is to analyze the Cast Vote Record (CVR). Various SC citizens have issued FOIA (Freedom of Information Act) requests to the counties and the State Election Commission (SEC) to obtain these records so that we can analyze past and future elections. **All requests were denied**, even though these records have always been available... until the 2018 midterm election.

They were denied based on an opinion letter issued by the Attorney General in September 2020, stating that the CVRs contained "personally identifiable information." This is simply NOT TRUE. If you go to our website, you will find the true composition of CVRs.

More than half of the states in the US have provided CVRs to local citizens including Georgia, Pennsylvania, Colorado, and California, to name a few. **South Carolina** has withheld this information from its citizens.

We filed a lawsuit against the SEC and Attorney General to obtain these records, and the judge issued a temporary restraining order to prevent their destruction. (A WIN!) Now the publicly-funded lawyers retained by the opposing parties have filed a counterclaim, to which our legal team is responding. **No matter what the cost, we will not give up this battle for transparent elections in SC.**

South Carolina Constitution Article II SECTION 1. "All elections by the people shall be by secret ballot, but the ballots shall not be counted in secret. The right of suffrage, as regulated in this Constitution, shall be protected by laws regulating elections and prohibiting, under adequate penalties, all undue influence from power, bribery, tumult, or improper conduct. (1970 (56) 2691; 1971 (57) 319.)"
